For those students working toward an ultimate goal in architecture or related design fields, the Summer Experience Scholarship Program is intended as a learning process for architectural and interior design education, providing specialized training enrichment and knowledge to prepare students for the rigors of studio in architectural school.

Application Requirements
This is a scholarship program

1. In order to be considered for our internship program applicants **must be** entering freshman year of college or higher and must submit portfolio/work examples, as well as present their work at an interview.
2. All applicants must have a strong interest in either architecture or interior design. Applicants must be in Architecture and/or Design school and have a strong interest in the profession and would like to gain some experience in our office.
3. Student Scholars will receive architectural supplies for their permanent use, such as basic drafting equipment; colored pencils etc. (Supplies vary year to year).
4. An added benefit of our program is ongoing mentorship. For those transferring majors into Architecture, portfolio preparation is available. Letters of recommendation to colleges must be requested at least 30 days prior to deadlines.
5. Scholar student acceptance is limited to a maximum of five students per summer. **Please see below for semester dates and application deadlines.**

Summer Break- The Summer Internship Experience

June 1st through August prior to interview. June 1st is typical the typical date schedule/dates vary. Application deadline is April 1st. Portfolio of work must be submitted for consideration.
